

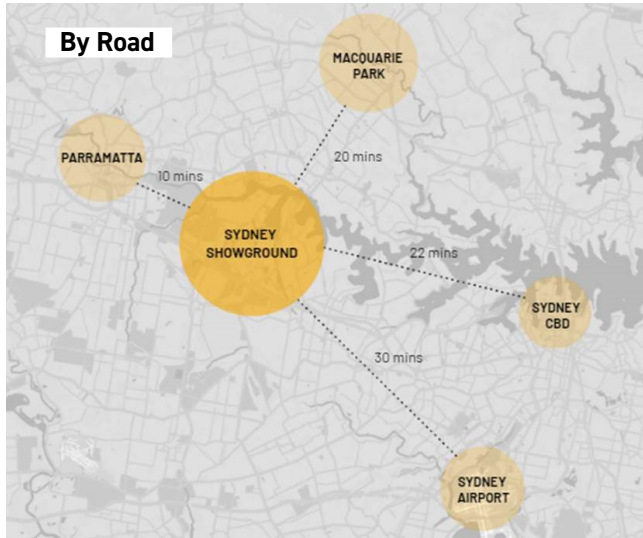


## Accessibility

Sydney Showground is situated within Sydney Olympic Park (SOP) on the traditional lands of the Burramattagal and Wangal People of the Eora Nation. Access and inclusion played a major role in the planning, design and delivery of the 2000 Olympic and Paralympic Games. It was also home to Invictus Games Sydney 2018 when the Dome was transformed into 'Invictus Games House' home to family and friends for the duration of the Games. This legacy has helped ensure our venues are accessible to all patrons.

## Accessible Location

Sydney Olympic Park Town Centre has over 10,000 parking spaces and **376** accessible and mobility car parking spaces for people with disability, including **8 on-street accessible spaces on Showground Road.**

<b>Sydney CBD</b>	16 kms	22 mins by car
<b>Sydney Airport</b>	19 kms	30 mins by car
<b>Parramatta</b>	7 kms	10 mins by car
<b>Macquarie Business Park</b>	7 kms	20 mins by car

Sydney Olympic Park is signposted from the major roads that service the area:

- M4, Hill Rd, Silverwater Road (from the West),
- Victoria Road, Homebush Bay Drive (from the North),
- M4, Parramatta Road & Homebush Bay Drive (from the East).
- With the Cross-city tunnel reducing travel time to/from CBD to just 20mins.

## NSW Transport Options

Plan an accessible trip on public transport to Sydney Showground whether you use a mobility aid or have an assistance animal [Trip Planner](#). Just choose your options and select the accessibility check box or Call 13 22 32 ahead of your trip, so staff at your destination can assist you. If there is an accessible event, Sydney Showground will liaise with Sydney Trains to ensure there are ramp operators available at Lidcombe station to assist with access.

## Venues

All venues located within Sydney Showground have been designed to suit the requirements of people with disability (with the exception of North pods in Halls 2, 3 & 4). Easy pedestrian access with street access to all halls, as well as direct access to loading dock for clients.

## Amenities & Services

Large clear signage welcomes patrons on arrival to Sydney Showground, as well as via our giant rotating LED Screen.

**SYDNEY SHOWGROUND** has elevators, rest rooms and telephones that are designed to accommodate the needs of people with disability.

All rooms and areas located within any Pavilion, Hall and The Dome have been designed to suit these requirements (except Level 1 in Hall 2, 3 & 4)

- **Hearing Loop** in the Dome and Halls 2 – 4
- **376 accessible parking** spaces
- **67 accessible toilets** sitewide (including ENGIE stadium)
- **First Aid** room within the Dome Foyer
- **Kiss and drop off** areas (Removable fences across our site, changeable road signs to enable coach pick up/drop off/queuing and street level ramps)
- **Wheelchairs** can be hired through: Lifestyle and Rehab P: 1300 133 120.
- **Service/Guide Dogs** are permitted within our venue. A vet certificate must be provided for them to be onsite to cooperate with our biosecurity and identification badge or medallion displayed.

### ENGIE STADIUM

- **First Aid** is available for all stadium events. For sporting events, first aid is located under the scoreboard. For concerts and special events, please contact the venue.
- **Parents' Room and Baby Changing Facilities** are available on the outer concourse behind the Members Stand. All accessible toilets are also fitted with change tables. For concerts and special events, please contact the venue.
- **Accessible Seating** is available on concourse level of the Stadium.

- **Accessible Toilets** 19 accessible toilets within ENGIE Stadium.
- **Assistance to your Seat.** If you require assistance to your seat, gate staff are able to assist with a wheelchair.
- **Prams** are required to be folded and placed under your seat or left in one of the designated pram bays located near aisles 201, 221, 402 and 431
- All **catering facilities** are accessible
- **Ramp facilities** are available at the back of Vincent Fairfax Stand & at both internal and external entrance to members foyer
